## Present Simple

### Uses:

- You use the Present Simple when you want to talk about something you do regularly. *"I usually catch the bus."*
- To talk about facts that are generally true. *"The sun rises every day."*
- You can also use the present simple when you want to talk about your thoughts and feelings at the present moment. *"I don't want to feel as if you don't like me."*

**Affirmative**

- I / You / We / They wake up at 7 o'clock.
- He / She / It wakes up at 7 o'clock

**Negative**

- I / You / We / They don't wake up at seven o'clock.
- He / She / It doesn't wake up at seven o'clock

**Interrogative**

- Do I / You / We / They wake up at seven o'clock?
- Does He / She / It wake up at seven o'clock?

**Short answers**

- yes, I/we/they do  
No, I / we / they don't.
- Yes, he/she/it does.  
No, he/she / it doesn't.

**Form:**

Always, often, usually, sometimes, frequently, seldom, every day, once a week, generally...

**Uses:**

They indicate how often something occurs and are generally used with Present Simple.

**Position:** We usually put these adverbs:

- Before full verbs: drive, say, feel.
- After the verb be.
